The Faculty of Homeopathy promotes the academic and scientific development of homeopathy and ensures the highest standards in the education, training and practice of homeopathy by dental surgeons, doctors, nurses, midwives, pharmacists, podiatrists, veterinary surgeons and other statutorily registered healthcare professionals. The Faculty, which was incorporated by an Act of Parliament in 1950, has over 1,400 members throughout the world.

Accredited postgraduate courses are delivered at five locations in the UK and seven overseas. Course provision differs by location so please review the table below to see which teaching centre can best cater to your needs.

Students are encouraged to sit the examinations which lead to the Faculty's qualifications: **LFHom**<sup>1</sup>, **DFHom**<sup>2</sup> & **MFHom/Vet MFHom**<sup>3</sup>.

**Training is open to health care professionals who hold a qualification that is statutorily registerable in the UK.**

All Faculty-accredited courses are extensive in the depth and breadth of subject matter covered, and practitioners will be expected to gain an understanding of the areas outlined below:

- core principles and concepts of homeopathy;
- the historical and philosophical background to the development of homeopathy;
- current scientific evidence;
- homeopathic pharmacy and materia medica;
- consultation and case analysis skills.

Once their training is complete, practitioners will have gained an appreciation of the scope and limits of homeopathy within contemporary medicine, and how this knowledge can be applied within their particular discipline and level of practice.

**1. Foundation Training** is appropriate for healthcare practitioners who wish to understand the basic principles of homeopathy. The curriculum specifies the core knowledge required for the **Primary Health Care Examination (PHCE)** and the **LFHom (Vet)** examination.

Successful candidates are eligible to become Licenced Associates of the Faculty and may use the letters **LFHom** followed by a suffix denoting the practitioner's profession. Those who began training in 2006 will need to pass the **PHCE** before they can apply for the **MFHom** examination

- 2. Diploma Level Training** is available for dentists, pharmacists and podiatrists. It equips practitioners to use homeopathy extensively in conditions appropriate to, and within, the accepted bounds of competence of their particular profession, and prepares students to sit the **Diploma examinations**. Successful candidates are eligible to become Diplomate members and dentists may use the letters **DFHom (Dent)**, pharmacists **DFHom (Pharm)** and podiatrists **DFHom (Pod)**.
- 3. MFHom Training** expands substantially on introductory training and prepares doctors, nurses, vets and pharmacists who satisfy the entry criteria for the **Membership Examination**. Successful candidates are eligible to become full members of the Faculty and may use the letters **MFHom**, **MFHom (Nurse)**, **MFHom (Pharm)** or **VetMFHom**.
